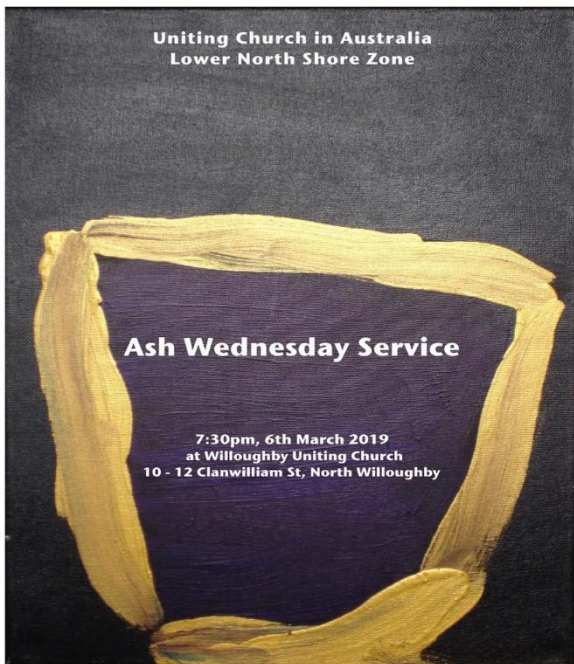
### Kids Alive Picnic – 10<sup>th</sup> March
